for the June 8 Republican Primary Elections

On June 8, 2010, many pro-life Republicans will be seeking election and re-election in federal and state races. It is a credit to the Republican Party in South Carolina that most of the candidates have excellent pro-life credentials based on their surveys, voting records where applicable, or championship of pro-life issues.
